DR Congo – Pray for our partners in the Congo as they face internal violence from some rebel groups. Pray for their safety, and that God's mercy, grace and peace would be upon the people. Pray that COVID-19 would not spread in this country, as an outbreak would be devastating.

Lebanon – Praise God that some of our activities in Lebanon have been able to resume in the midst of COVID-19. But please continue to pray for the many refugees in the camp, who still are negatively impacted, and who have very little in terms of comfort. Pray for other project proposals, that if approved would help many more in need. Pray for our partners in the area, that God would protect them and keep them safe in the midst of the pandemic.

India – Praise God that none of the families we serve in India have contracted COVID-19 because of the successful training and prevention projects donors helped fund! Despite this, please continue to pray for India as a whole, which has recorded many cases - especially in the crowded slums. Pray for the government, that God's wisdom and guidance would be upon them as they continue to battle this pandemic.

Canadian Foodgrains Bank – Please pray for small-scale farmers, especially women who are facing increased risk of hunger during the pandemic. Pray they have the health and strength necessary to continue the farm work that feeds their families. Pray also that their farms flourish despite the new challenges of restricted movement of products to market and reduced access to seeds, tools and other necessary inputs.
