Armed rebels are near the city of Beni and Ebola has still not been contained due to the insecurity. The national elections that were held on December 30th were violent. Pray for wisdom for the current and new leaders and safety for everyone.

Pray for South Sudan - There is a fragile peace and power-sharing arrangement in South Sudan. Pray for the peace treaty to hold and for the millions of people displaced to be able to return home. We pray the churches will be involved in bringing healing to a traumatized nation, including the many women who have been raped.

Please pray for a good growing season - in central Tanzania (Dodoma region) the rains have started, so some farmers have planted crops. Pray the rains will be steady in this dry area.
