She is working towards owning land and a house, and growing her business and her future from there. She tastes freedom – the fact of Jubilee - and knows that she is a child of God.

# THE PEOPLE OF DRC LONG FOR THE REALITY OF GOD'S JUBILEE

**If it weren't for the Church, people in eastern Democratic Republic of Congo would struggle on their own.**

There's little help from the government due to corruption, apathy, and lack of resources. Rebel groups are a perpetual risk.

The most important cash crop – bananas – are being decimated by disease, ruining the livelihoods of thousands of families.

Ebola killed 2,000 people over the last 3 years, and a current outbreak of measles has already taken 6,000 lives.

And now the COVID-19 lockdown is paralyzing farm systems – seeds are not available, farmers cannot move their crops to market, and have no cash. Serious food shortages are a growing threat.

But the people of DRC work furiously to survive, to give their families a better future, and to nurture their communities towards a healthy self-sufficiency.

And churches - like our partner the Baptist Church in Central Africa - lead the way.

# WHAT WILL JUBILEE LOOK LIKE THIS YEAR FOR BIRUNGI AND HER NEIGHBOURS?

*Being able to feed your family. Getting seeds to plant for the next harvest. Ensuring your neighbours are cared for. Proclaiming the Kingdom of Christ*

## **This is Jubilee.**

Jubilee provides us with a reminder of God's mission of redemption, restoration, and sovereignty. A foretaste of what heaven will be like. As Christians, we are called to continue the spirit of Jubilee, to reflect God's mission of restoration on Earth today.

Canadian donors like you have already had a profound effect in a dozen large rural communities, where Tearfund is working with our church partner.

Recently, more than 1,000 families took training in conservation agriculture, helping them grow more nutritious and plentiful crops. Today, the training focuses on expanding crop diversity to fight food shortages.

At the same time, more than 70 village savings groups were formed, attracting more than 1,850 members, fueling the vision and success of people like Birungi.

But this year, COVID struck, and farms, families, and futures are at risk. As cash dries up, the savings groups are stalling.

If we have the resources, we will do all we can to:

- prevent families slipping back into poverty and hunger
- expand conservation agriculture and savings groups
- support farmers to reduce the damage of COVID-19 shutdowns

## THE IMPACT YOUR GIFT WILL HAVE

1. **COVID-19 awareness and prevention** – Promote COVID-19 prevention techniques through radio and printed leaflets and posters.
2. **Keep on** – Your gift today will help recruit more people to agriculture training and village savings groups; two proven methods of helping families escape poverty for good.
3. **Diversify crops** – You will help transition farmers from growing more perishable crops to ones that don't rot quickly, like potatoes and onions, and expand to growing cash crops such as garlic and ginger.
4. **Strengthen community (Part 1)** – Create farming cooperatives to help farmers sell their harvest at fair prices.
5. **Strengthen community (Part 2)** – Open small 'canteens' in villages – places for farmers to store and sell their products and also purchase basic necessities, and seeds at a fair price.
6. **Strengthen community (Part 3)** – Develop new ways for rural farmers to get crops to market in neighbouring towns and cities.
7. **Invest directly in savings groups with seeds** – Help continue the success of savings groups by investing seeds as cash to the groups, Use grants and loans of seeds to ensure crops get planted despite pandemic restrictions.

These strategies will put more people like Buringi on the path to freedom from poverty, and their own personal experience of Jubilee.
