As the war in Ukraine rages on, millions of people around the world are now in danger of being pushed into poverty and malnutrition. And while news crews are, justifiably, focused on the front-lines, the ripple effects are changing life thousands of kilometers away in some of the world's poorest places.

Did you know that fourteen African countries depend on Russia and Ukraine for more than half of their wheat imports, while almost half of African countries depend on more than a third? Within a matter of weeks, the war has already pushed grain prices up more than 25%! This has catastrophic impacts on the world's poorest families—who already struggle to eat one decent meal a day.

Thankfully, donors like you are already making a difference.

In response to the deeping hunger crisis, people like you have helped us start several projects to help meet the need. In Ethiopia, where inflation is rampant, we are working with the Terepeza Development Association to help farmers grow more food to eat but also provide emergency food. In South Sudan we just launched a \$1 million project aimed at providing 12,000 individuals with enough food last the next three months of the hunger season.

Generous donations from people like you provide a lifeline in such uncertain times. Thank you for your ongoing support and continue to pray for all those who are suffering throughout the world.



Cash Cow!

How Canadian farmers are helping end poverty around the world.

(And how you can help)

Growing up in the small town of Listowel, Ontario, Nathan Tollenaar remembers long days on the farm. One of the most exciting things growing up was being involved in one of the many Grow Projects around his home. "As long as I can remember, my family always had a growing project," Nathan says.

These Grow Projects, run by thousands of Canadian farmers, all have one goal: **to end the scourge of hunger around the world.** With the support of donors across Canada, farmers donate a portion of the sale of their crops to Tearfund—which are used to help poor farmers around the world grow more food.

So when Nathan's family moved to Stonewall, Manitoba, he was shocked to learn that there wasn't already a grow project in the area. So at age 19, he set out to change this.

First, Nathan found Andrew and Nick – two other young men and together they founded the Rock Solid Grow Project in 2016. But there was a problem. They had no land, no seed, or any fertilizer. How could they grow anything? It's hard to grow crops without land!



So that Christmas they approached their church to help them get started. And on a cold Christmas eve, the members of New Life Baptist Church came together for a special offering. In total they raised \$8,000 to fund the start-up costs!

Now, six years later, the Grow project has raised over \$154,000 to help families living in the poorest places on earth lift themselves out of poverty. But these three friends weren't finished yet.

As one of them put it, "we asked ourselves if there were any other ways we could work together to raise more money for the project? What else did God give us that we could use?" Then they took a look.

Alex's family owns a sod company so he set out to donate some sod. Last year a whole 40ft flatbed of sod was donated to help the world's poor. But that was nothing to their next idea.

The three young men then decided to donate cows.

With Tearfund's investment, two heifers were purchased. Over the next 10 years, all Calves born will be sold with the proceeds going to help train farmers in the world's poorest places. Each calf is expected to be sold for \$800 to \$1,600.

Soybeans, Sod, and Calves. The impact that these things will have on the poor all around the world will be extraordinary. What do you have in your hand?



How it works



Canadian farmers donate land and time to grow crops



Non-farming Canadians help by donating the cost of rent, seed, fertilizer and insurance





Crops are sold and proceeds are deposited into Tearfund's account at the **Foodgrains Bank**. On average, for every \$300 spent on farming inputs, \$500 is generated as profit







Money donated into Foodgrains Bank are matched up to **4:1** in partnership with the **Government of Canada.**



Money is sent to support farming projects around the world to help families out of poverty!



After all is said and done, through this unique arrangement your \$300 has the potential to transform into \$2000 worth of live-changing projects!
