## Pray for Ethiopia

- We praise God for His providence in our work in Ethiopia! From our Conservation Agriculture projects, to the successful food aid distribution that helped many families.
- Pray for the farmers in Ethiopia, that they would have bountiful harvests, and that God would continue give them strength.
- War still ravages the country; many are dying, people are losing their livelihoods and millions are being uprooted from their houses and villages. Pray for peace in Ethiopia, that God would move His hands and intervene.
- Pray for the 27 churches in our new church and community transformation project. That they would be strengthened by God and act as lights within their villages. That God would use them powerfully to lift families out of physical and spiritual poverty.
- Pray also for our local partner, the Terepeza Development Association as they implement their projects through this trying times.



## Pray for India

- We praise God for our partnership with EFICOR and their faithful service ministering to the poor in India for over 50 years!

- Pray for the churches, that they would reach out to their hurting neighbours and provide physical and spiritual restoration.






## Pray for Sierra Leone

- Praise God for a new project being implemented by the Evangelical Fellowship of Sierra Leone (EFSL), our local partner. With the generous support of our Canadian donors like you, the EFSL has introduced cassava processing machines in communities to help women crush cassava root into flour!
- Pray for this exciting development in Sierra Leone, that it will continue to empower women to sell cassava flour to provide for their families and lift themselves out of extreme poverty.
- Pray also that it would help them provide food and provision for families that suffer from chronic hunger.
- Pray for all the staff of EFSL as they continue to engage communities in COVID-19 education and hygiene promotion.
- Pray for churches in the area – especially young believers – for the grace of God upon their lives, by staying in the faith and relying on God.



## Pray for South Sudan

- Every day, people in South Sudan live in fear under the threat and reality of violence, climatic shocks and poverty. The floods that started around June 2021 which ravaged and displaced many families has yet to recede.
- Please pray for the country, that God's divine providence would be upon the people. Pray for love and peace, and that the violence and conflict would eventually be resolved.
- Pray for the floods to recede so families can go back to their homes & rebuild.
- Sexual and gender violence is massive in South Sudan. Please pray for our biblically-based sexual violence rehabilitation project, that God would heal the deep wounds many survivors carry. That churches can model justice and light to their communities and be a source of hope.
- Pray also for our new HERD project, which aims to take families from relief to sustainability. Pray that the work continues to go well and that families make progress with the farming training.






## Pray for Lebanon

- Lebanon is facing an unprecedented economic and financial crisis that is impacting the lives of the most vulnerable, including Syrian refugees. Individuals and families are falling deeper into poverty due to high inflation, rising food prices and a loss of income. The COVID-19 outbreak has exacerbated the situation by reducing people's access to food, livelihood opportunities and other basic services.
- Pray for all the families and individuals who are affected. Pray that God would intervene and work through this very difficult time.
- Pray for our local partner, Medair, who are on the frontlines meeting the needs of vulnerable people in Lebanon.
- Pray for an end to the growing crisis in the country. Pray that God would protect the most vulnerable during this difficult time.



## Pray for Haiti

- Since August 2021, Tearfund Canada has partnered with 12 Christian humanitarian organizations to respond to the Haiti earthquake and flooding crisis. Our response is one small part of a larger \$937,000 project that is being led by World Renew. Please continue to pray for Haitians who have lost everything in the earthquake and flooding.
- Please continue to pray for the families who have lost loved ones, their homes, and their livelihoods in these devastating disasters.
- Pray for our partners and local response teams as they seek to address the overwhelming needs.
- Pray that God would give endurance and hope in the midst of the challenges that are being faced in Haiti.





## Pray for the *Cote First Nations Project*

- In Dec 2021, 22 Buffalo were introduced back to Cote First Nation land after over 150 years. Pray that this project continues to build reconciliation with First Nations people and that God would use it to build friendships and bring hope to this community.
- Pray that many churches and Christians come alongside us for this project now and in the future. Pray also that churches and Christians would lament over the past wrongs that were committed and seek to heal the deep pain that many of their First Nation neighbours feel. Pray that God's people would be a people of justice and comfort.
- Pray for our local partner, Youth with a Mission (YWAM) Loko Koa as they continue to work with Cote First Nation on this project. This will be the 3rd herd started by them in the past 7 years and prior herds have been a wonderful source of blessing and witness.
- Pray for Chief George Cote, a wonderful Christian and for healing of relationships.
