Pray for Ethiopia as people continue to battle hunger and climate stress, with the World Food Programme now unable to reach over 650,000 malnourished mothers and children due to funding shortages. Pray that help and support would quickly reach those in need, and that those affected would remain strong. Ask God to provide and show mercy, bringing hope and strength in this difficult season.

Pray for the DR Congo as heavy rains have triggered floods and landslides in Kinshasa, killing at least 29 people, and another landslide at Rubaya mine claimed many more lives. Pray that survivors receive aid, and for communities to recover quickly. Pray for guidance for relief workers and bring comfort to those who are grieving and displaced. Additionally, pray for the safety and well-being of our local partner working tirelessly in the region. May God's peace prevail in the DR Congo.

Pray for India as communities struggle with natural disasters that threaten the most vulnerable. Flash floods in Himachal Pradesh recently swept away homes and injured workers, and heavy pre-monsoon rains in Assam and Cachar have damaged crops and left thousands cut off from aid. Pray for strength and protection for rescue teams and health workers helping in remote areas. Ask God to provide clean water, food, and medicine to families affected, and to guide rebuilding efforts that restore both homes and hope.

Pray for Kenya as northern communities struggle with worsening drought that threatens food and water security. Pray for practical aid and farming support to sustain families, especially children at risk of dropping out of school. May God bring both practical help and spiritual strength to these communities. Pray also for our local partner Fadhili Trust as they continue to serve the most vulnerable.

Pray for South Sudan as many communities continue to face severe food shortages caused by ongoing conflict, displacement, and climate-related challenges like flooding and drought. Millions are at risk of hunger, and families struggle daily to access enough food and clean water. Pray that God would provide relief and protection for those most vulnerable, especially children and the elderly. Pray for strength and wisdom for our local partners as they serve in difficult conditions. May peace take root in the land, and may God's provision and mercy be seen in every effort to restore lives and rebuild communities.

Pray for Tanzania as it continues to recover from the recent El Niño-driven floods and landslides that have affected over 200,000 people, destroying homes and crops in regions like Morogoro, Manyara, Kigoma, and Dar es Salaam. Pray for effective relief to reach families in need, providing shelter, clean water, food, and health support. May God grant wisdom and resources to build stronger defenses against future disasters and bring hope to those rebuilding their lives.
