Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our affliction, so that we may be able to comfort those who are in any affliction, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God.

2 Corinthians 1:3-4

Pray for Ethiopia as communities continue to face hunger and malnutrition, especially among mothers and children. Reports show that ongoing food shortages remain critical, affecting millions who rely on relief efforts. Ask God to touch the hearts of donors to provide resources quickly, and for aid teams to reach those most in need. May God's mercy bring hope and strength to families struggling to feed their little ones.

Pray for the DR Congo as its people cope with falling food aid stocks due to global cuts. Specialized life-saving food like Plumpy'Nut is at risk of running out for many malnourished children, further deepening the crisis. Pray that new support would arrive in time. May God grant relief and sustenance to the most vulnerable.

Pray for India as the monsoon floods continue to impact many communities where relief efforts are underway. Recent efforts include rescue missions using over 20 aircraft to reach stranded families and community groups and volunteers stepping up to distribute food, clean water, and shelter. Pray that these efforts, whether by government, organizations, or individuals, continue to bring healing and practical help. May God guide every hand involved and bring comfort and hope to those who are suffering.

Pray for Kenya as urgent food needs rise in refugee camps, with the World Food Programme warning that supplies of therapeutic food for malnourished children could run dry by October due to aid cuts. Pray that God would provide the needed resources so that children and families receive the food and care they desperately need.

Pray for South Sudan as communities continue to face hunger and hardship, even while giving thanks for the food assistance that recently reached over 10,000 people. With good rains falling, families are now able to plant and grow food for themselves. We are grateful for the support of partners, donors, and the Canadian government that helped make this possible. Pray that the harvest will be plentiful, that future support will continue, and that God will strengthen communities to build a more stable and hopeful future.

Pray for Tanzania as new sustainable farming projects take root. Initiatives exploring techniques aim to build stronger livelihoods for rural families facing drought and weather shifts. Pray for these programs to thrive, empowering communities to feed themselves and protect the land. May God's wisdom guide local leaders as they foster growth and resilience.



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Pray for Afghanistan. A devastating 6.0-magnitude earthquake that struck eastern Afghanistan late Sunday night. Reports confirm that more than 800 people have lost their lives, with thousands more injured. Pray for the injured and those trapped, that they may receive swift medical care and experience healing. Pray for families mourning loved ones, that God's peace would surround them. And pray for the rebuilding efforts to be swift and effective, providing shelter and aid to those in need.

Pray for our local partners around the world, as they faithfully do the hard work of serving communities in need. We give thanks to the Lord for their dedication and the impact they make every day in difficult places. Please praise that God would continue to strengthen them with wisdom, protection, and encouragement, and pray that our relationships with them would remain strong and united in Christ as we serve together.
